Calendar Changes: We want to make you aware of a few changes to our school calendar.

- **Science Fair**—We will now have our Science Fair on Friday, February 2 from 3:15—6:00 pm. Come after school and look at all of the projects. Many of them will be located in the classrooms and some will be lining the hallway.
- **Graduation**—8th grade graduation will now be on Thursday, May 23 at 4:00 pm. Following graduation will be Awards and the school picnic.
- **Last Day of School** will still be on Friday, May 24 but we will have an early release at 12 noon.

Church Attendance: Every week, church attendance will be taken in kindergarten through 8th grade. Its intent is to encourage an active worship life in our school families. Please make weekly worship the highlight of your week.

Midweek Chapel & Mission Offering: Each Wednesday (8:15 am) throughout the school year, Trinity conducts a midweek chapel service. This year's chapel focuses around the theme, "Walk with God! Talk with God!". All mission offerings collected at our Wednesday morning chapel services will go to WELS Campus Ministry. To date we have collected \$277.67. We encourage and invite all of our preschool and K-8 parents and families to join the students for this 15-minute service each week.
