Parent/Teacher Conferences: Thank you for the opportunity to discuss your student's progress during Parent/Teacher Conferences. Please know that the teachers' doors are always open to address your questions and concerns if they arise.

Church Attendance: Every week, church attendance will be taken in kindergarten through 8th grade. Its intent is to encourage an active worship life in our school families. Please make weekly worship the highlight of your week.

Midweek Chapel & Mission Offering: Each Wednesday (8:15 am) throughout the school year, Trinity conducts a midweek chapel service. We encourage and invite all of our preschool and K-8 parents and families to join the students for this 15-minute service each week. This year's chapel focuses around the theme, "Walk with God! School Absences: If your student will not be in school on a given day due to illness, please either call the school office to leave a message or contact your student's teacher directly.
