**MAP Growth Testing (Grades 3-8):** Results from last week's testing will be coming home with your student soon. If you have any questions on this report, please contact your child's teacher.

**No Bus:** Please be aware that Trinity will have no bussing provided on Monday, October 9. The public schools will not be in session that day.

**Church Attendance:** Every week, church attendance will be taken in kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Its intent is to encourage an active worship life in our school families. Please make weekly worship the highlight of your week.

**Midweek Chapel:** Each Wednesday (8:15 am) throughout the school year, Trinity conducts a midweek chapel service. We encourage and invite all of our preschool and K-8 parents and families to join the students for this 15-minute service each week. This year's chapel focuses around the theme, "Walk with God! Talk with God!".

**Mission Offering 2023-2024:** All mission offerings collected at our Wednesday morning chapel services will go to WELS Campus Ministry. To date we have collected \$57.02.

**School Absences:** If your student will not be in school on a given day due to illness, please either call the school office to leave a message or contact your student's teacher directly. Only parents can excuse an absence; siblings cannot. A Notice of Absence sheet (available in the school office or online) needs to be filled out when an absence is preplanned. It should be returned to your student's teacher prior to the absence. Thanks for your cooperation!
